

Duncan and Anne lived at Drumore House, Campbeltown. As Sheriff Substitute, Duncan took statements from those who witnessed the Corphin Mermaid




**ANNE CAMPBELL**

*“dinna fash wi’ the wrinkles”*


**DONALD MACMILLAN**
